This agreement is to produce one (1) foal from the above-mentioned mare regardless of the breeding methods used. ET and ICSI is permitted. If semen shipments are used for a mare other than named in this agreement or multiple embryos are produced, the standard posted breeding fee and completed contract shall be due and submitted to Eurequine, LLC. immediately.

In the event of stallion's death or the inability to produce and ship viable semen from the stallion contracted for this service, Stallion Manager shall substitute this fresh semen agreement for either frozen semen from the same stallion, if available, or the mare owner may choose fresh semen from another Stallion owned by the Stallion Manager.

Stallion Manager guarantees breeding privileges for the contracted mare during one breeding season and guarantees no return breeding privileges unless the LF30DG in the next paragraph applies. A mare may be substituted with permission of the Stallion Manager and a statement from a licensed veterinarian confirming the original mare on contract is barren. A transfer fee is due to substitute a mare. This contract's ownership is not transferable.

<u>LF30DG</u> - Should the mare not produce a live foal that stands, sucks and survives the first <u>30 days</u> after birth, mare owner shall be entitled to above-mentioned return privileges. This guarantee shall only apply if the stallion manager is notified within one week of the foal's death. A statement of details by a licensed veterinarian must follow within 10 days or the guarantee becomes null and void. This clause is also binding in case of abortion. If the mare lost her pregnancy, Stallion Manager needs written verification of this fact, mailed, or emailed from the attending veterinarian.

The Mare <u>Owner shall assume all responsibility for the condition of the mare</u> and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to the mare whether by death, disease, injury, infection or otherwise, and by any cause whatsoever, and therefore agrees to hold the stallion manager, owner, keeper, or agent harmless for all damages associated therewith.

We do not require proof of a clean culture. We do expect you to follow your veterinarian's recommendation for best results. Fees, collection and shipping requirements: A credit card to pay for shipping container, collection and shipping is required to order semen. Each collection is \$195. Shipments outside of the season and orders placed after 9 am on the same day of shipment are subject to a \$50 charge. Approximate transportation costs are: Federal Express: \$130.00; Air Lines Counter to Counter: \$105.00; Courier Service to Airport: \$130.00. High quality disposable containers: \$35, do not need to be returned.
